SUGGESTED ITINERARY

DAY 01

Welcome to Jordan- 'The Holy Land'

Welcome to Amman, Jordan. Meet and assist by our airport representative, who will assist you through immigration and customs. Transfer to hotel & check in. Overnight in Amman.

Note: Passengers joining directly / NRI passengers may check in at the hotel on their own. Standard check-in time is 1500 hrs. in at the hotel.

DAY 02

Proceed to Wadi Rum - known as the valley of the moons; enjoy a thrilling jeep tour of Wadi rum. Onto Petra.

Today, proceed to Wadi Rum - a valley cut into the sandstone and granite rock in southern Jordan known for its towering rock formations, slender valleys, and infinite skies (Distance 320km). Enjoy Jeep Safari at Wadi Rum. Later, transfer to Petra. Overnight in Petra.

DAY 03

Explore Petra . Drive to Dead Sea.

Today, proceed to explore Petra. Visit the Petra Treasury area – One of the 7 Wonders of the World. A short horse ride is included or you can upgrade to an electric buggy at an additional cost of USD 35 per person (Tips not included for horse ride and buggy). Proceed to the Dead Sea, the lowest point on earth deep in the Jordan Valley. Evening is free to explore the hotel or enjoy a dip in the dead sea and enjoy the sunset. Check in at the hotel in Dead Sea

Overnight at Dead Sea.

DAY 04

Dead Sea – Madaba – Mt. Nebo – Amman

After breakfast, free time in Dead Sea. Proceed to Madaba - known as the "City of Mosaics", Madaba is the cultural epicenter for Byzantine and Umayyad mosaics. Proceed to Mt. Nebo - a sacred elevated ridge in Jordan, overlooking the Jordan River Valley and Dead Sea. Continue your tour of Amman, see the Citadel -Temple of Hercules ruins etc. Later, see the Roman Amphitheatre.

Overnight in Amman.

Transfers: Transfers by coach

DAY 05

Depart Jordan and Welcome to Egypt

Depart from Amman Airport and arrive at Cairo. On arrival, Transfers to the hotel. (Standard hotel check-in time: 1500 hrs). Enjoy a relaxed evening.

Overnight stay at a hotel in Cairo.

DAY 06**Explore - Pyramids and Sphinx, Papyrus and Perfumery, GEM – The Grand Egyptian Museum Guided tour**

Transfer to visit the Pyramids of Giza and Sphinx. Entrance inside the Pyramids is not included. Stop at perfumery & papyrus shops. Enjoy a guided tour of the GEM – The Grand Egyptian Museum. Overnight in Cairo.

Transfers: Transfers by coach

DAY 07**Cairo to Aswan early morning flight. Visit the Temples of Abu Simbel.**

Proceed to the airport for your flight to Aswan. Upon arrival we proceed to Abu Simbel. Visit the temple of Abu Simbel - A UNESCO world heritage site. Visit the Great Temple of Ramses II and the Small Temple of Nefertari (Temple of Hathor). Return to Aswan and check into the Nile Cruise. Driving one way is approximately 3 hours distance. Overnight on board the River Nile Cruise.

Note: Due to limited flight options you will have to take an early morning flight from Cairo

DAY 08**Visit the temple of Philae and the High Dam. Visit Kom Ombo Temple and Crocodile Museum**

Today, Visit the temple of Philae by motorboat. Visit the High Dam (Photography not allowed). Sail north to Kom Ombo Temple, dedicated to the crocodile god Sobek and falcon-headed god Horus.

Overnight on board the River Nile Cruise.

DAY 09**Visit Edfu Temple, Sail via the Esna Lock to Luxor.**

Today, sail to Edfu . Visit Edfu temple dedicated to God Horus. Enjoy Nile River from the deck, as your Nile Cruise sails to Luxor via the Esna Lock. Visit the Temple of Luxor, it was built by Amunhotep III

Overnight on board the River Nile Cruise.

DAY 10**West Bank of Luxor – Valley of Kings, Temple of Queen Hatshepsut, Karnak Temple, and proceed to the Red Sea resort town of Hurghada.**

Check out from your cruise and visit the Valley of The Kings. Next, visit the Temple of Queen Hatshepsut , Photostop at The Colossi of Memnon. Proceed to Karnak Temple, dedicated to the God Amon, his wife Mut and their son Khonsu. Next drive towards Egypt's stunning Red Sea coast – Hurghada (Driving time Approx 4 hours). Check in your hotel and overnight in Hurghada.

Transfers: Transfers by coach

DAY 11**Semi Sub Ride at Hurghada**

Experience the magic of the Red Sea with a semi-sub tour from Hurghada – see the Wonders of the Red Sea coral reefs through the windows of the observation decks. Back to the hotel to enjoy the hotel facilities. Overnight in Hurghada.

DAY 12**Drive towards Cairo. (Driving time Approx 6 hours)**

This morning proceed towards Cairo. Upon arrival check in your hotel and evening free. Overnight in Cairo.

After breakfast, transfer to Cairo airport. Flight back home. Check out time is 1000 hrs.

Important Note:

- The routing of the itinerary may change as per flight & hotel availability.
- Please DO NOT issue any tickets without confirming with TCIL team.
- 04 passengers in one room are not allowed. Maximum capacity is 03 passengers. Cruise cabins for 3 passengers would also be with limited space.
- Standard Hotel check-in time will be 1500 hours and check out at 1000 hrs.

IMPORTANT NOTE FOR EGYPT:

1. **Early Starts for Better Experiences:** To ensure you see Jordan and Egypt’s world-famous monuments in the best possible light and avoid the peak midday warmth, many of our tours and domestic flights are scheduled for the early morning. Starting your day early allows you to enjoy the sites while they are quieter and more comfortable.
2. **Brisk Itineraries:** Jordan and Egypt are home to an incredible density of historical treasures. To help you experience as many of these wonders as possible, our daily schedules are designed to be efficient. While this means time at individual temples may be structured, it ensures you don't miss any of the highlights on your itinerary.
3. **Seamless Transitions:** Because of the early morning nature of sightseeing, you may find that domestic flight timings are also scheduled early.

4. On board the Nile Cruise while local meals are included, bottled water and other beverages are charged separately, allowing you to choose exactly what you'd like to drink as you sail.
5. Please visit the dedicated registration office at Terminal 1, 2, or 3 immediately upon arrival to obtain your triangle-shaped registration stamp if your stay in Egypt is more than 7 days. A fee of USD 15 per person is payable directly to travellers aged 16 to 60. Note: To avoid a fine of 900 EGP (plus the \$15 registration fee), please ensure you register upon arrival at Cairo airport.
6. A Nile River cruise is quite different from an Ocean cruise. Because they navigate the narrow and historic waters of the Nile, these vessels are smaller and more intimate—think of them as cozy, floating hotels rather than large resorts.

WHAT YOUR TOUR PRICE DOES NOT INCLUDE:

- International Air tickets required to participate in this tour.
- Visa, Insurance, Airport & Port taxes.
- Tipping in Egypt is expected from anyone providing services e.g., Coach Driver, Hotel & Restaurant staff etc. It is mandatory to tip a nominal amount of USD 5 per person/per day. For the entire duration of the tour which is to be paid to the Tour Manager on Day 01 of the tour.
- Registration fees at Cairo Airport for passengers between the age of 16 years to 60 years staying in Egypt for 7 nights or more.
- Any expenses of personal nature such as portorage, laundry expenses, mini-bar, mineral water, telephone charges, food & drink that are not a part of the package.
- Additional Meals that are not mentioned in the above itinerary.
- Cost of excursions, city sightseeing, entrance fees & local guides availed of by the passengers, other than that mentioned in the above itinerary.
- Cost of Optional Excursions.
- Any increase in the airfare charged by the airline on your air ticket (presently calculated as on 31st October 2025)

Transfers

Airport-to-group hotel and group hotel to airport transfers are included for NRI guests arriving between 07 AM and 09 PM on the arrival and departure day only. For transfers not falling within these timings a surcharge may apply. Early check and / or late check out is not included.

Note that Amman to Cairo is not considered as Internal flight as it's an international flight and not included for NRI client.

Airline requirements:

For this tour you would require confirmed air tickets Arrival in Amman and Depart from Cairo. It would be advisable to check with your sales officer or local travel agent for ticketing. **Internal flight from Cairo to Amman is included in tour price.**

Amman to Cairo is international flight and not included for NRI client.

Visa requirements: Egypt & Jordan Visa.

The cost of visa is not included in your package tour price. It would be best to check with your travel agent and the consulates nearest to you for advice and information

IMPORTANT NOTES:**AIRLINE AND AIRFARE**

- The airfare is based on the fare structure existing as on 31st January 2026.
- Any further increase in the airfare due to an increase in the fuel price, change in Government regulations, taxes, etc., charged by the airline will have to be borne by the passengers.
- Passengers missing flights note that the entire ticket gets no show and new return ticket needs to be bought by the passengers themselves.
- Passengers joining this tour must travel to/ from the hub city at their own expense.

HOTELS / CRUISE

- Most hotels in Jordan and Egypt have Twin beds. The double bed will be Queen size and not King size.
- As a 3rd person in a triple room, most hotels use rollaway beds and room size may be the same as the double room.
- For Child with bed: At times hotel don't have enough roll away beds, in that case they might give a double and a separate single room.
- A person 11.99 years and below is considered a child and 12 years and above, an adult.
- Functioning of Air cooling / Air conditioning in hotels is subject to official declaration of summer by the local authority.
- Due to international events and trade fairs in Jordan and Egypt such as the Eid holidays, Air Show, marathons, music festivals, etc., you may have to stay in hotels further away from the city.
- Any damage caused to the hotel rooms / cruise cabins / Coach during your stay shall be payable by the passengers.
- We also reserve the right to substitute a hotel / cruise of similar class if it is deemed advisable or necessary.
- Some cities don't have buffet breakfast in hotels. If this continues when tours

- begin, we will provide breakfast or take the groups to an Indian / local restaurant.
- It is important to note that hotel rooms in Egypt especially the Nile Cruise may be more compact / smaller in size than what you are accustomed to.

COACHES

- Coaches are an important part of your journeys & we request our guests to keep the coach clean.
- Due to hygienic reasons, it is not permitted to use toilets on the coach. However, the tour manager will make comfort stops during long drives.
- Eating & drinking is not permitted on the coach.
- Due to limited boot space in the coach, we suggest you carry one check-in bag & one handbag per person only
- In major Egypt cities, there are parking restrictions for coaches, and it may not be possible to stop at all the places during the city tour. Tour Manager will try his/her best to stop coach wherever possible for a photo stop.
- Coaches are non-wheelchair compliant. There are steps to board / alight from the coach.

MEALS

- Meals are pre-set & a-la carte is not possible.
- On certain Days packed lunch/breakfast will be provided.
- Water bottles will be provided by your guide and Tour Manager as per itinerary.
- Certain meals are by walking during your tour.
- Water is not included during any meals.

SIGHTSEEING

- On certain departures, we may sometimes amend / reverse the itinerary. However, all the services / inclusions will remain the same.
- Panoramic / Orientation tours are scenic drives conducted primarily from the coach. Only specific, pre-determined locations are visited on foot or include a photo stop.
- Guests should note that the itinerary requires early morning wake up calls, early morning flights, significant walking distances at various locations, including attractions, temples and airports. This is an inherent part of the tour experience. We recommend you bring a reliable, comfortable pair of sports shoes. Your Tour Manager and Driver will attempt to minimize walking by getting you as close to the entry points as regulations allow, but ultimate responsibility for navigating the walking portions rests with the guest.
- Every Site / Monuments has its own set of rules & regulations. We need to respect this & ensure that we follow the same.
- All our visits are booked in advance to avoid delays, at the same time there may

be delays caused due to overcrowding, local regulations, security checks etc.

- Most of the tours in Jordan and Egypt will commence early and are generally scheduled to conclude in the early evening. These schedules are based on weather conditions, local tourism operating norms and coach hours. Furthermore, guests are advised that local establishments, including restaurants and retail stores, often operate with shorter evening hours than in other countries.

GENERAL

- On some occasions you may have to join another group in case the group does not have adequate members.
- A local representative or a driver may only be there to assist you during your initial part of the tour.
- Arrival and Departure flights should be booked according to the group flight timings. In case there is any sightseeing involved on the first or last day of the itinerary, to avoid missing any of the services. Please check with your sales officer about the group flight timings.
- Security alerts and random closures might affect the itinerary.
- Please take extra care of your personal belongings while on the tour, every country you travel to is prone to thefts and bag snatching will not be liable for any loss of belongings / baggage.
- Disabled clients should carry their own wheelchair and should be accompanied by a qualified companion who is able to provide assistance to the disabled client.
- shall not accept any liability or responsibility for any damages, loss, baggage loss, theft, injury, accident, death, breakdown or irregularity, which may occur in carrying out the tour arrangement, weather conditions, strikes, war, quarantine and any other cause whatsoever and all such loss or expense must be borne by the passengers. Insurance policies must be carried while on tour.
- The management reserves the right to claim any additional expenses incurred due to delays or changes in schedules of train, airplane, bus, ship or other services.

Weather in Jordan and Egypt General Overview

- ✓ The country enters its hot and dry season during this window.
- ✓ April – May: Pleasant to warm, with temperatures typically between 20°C and 30°C. This is considered one of the best times for sightseeing.
- ✓ June – August: Peak Summer
- ✓ September: The start of the transition to cooler weather, though daytime highs in areas like Cairo still average around 34°C (93°F) early in the month.

Hurghada Weather (April – September 2026)

- ✓ Hurghada remains a popular destination due to its subtropical climate tempered by Red Sea breezes.
